GONE BUILDING!

When I was young, I loved to play with LEGO® bricks. I remember that my first set was the 336 Fire Truck. After getting my two sons, my interest was rekindled and we enjoyed building LEGO models together. Especially the Super Heroes sets are a favorite of my sons. Our storage room has been turned into a LEGO room for the boys. Don't ask my wife...

Fishing has always been my hobby. From fishing in the Caribbean, where I lived for a while, to fishing in Holland. So you could say that my interest in fishing and my job as an architectural draughtsman came together in this model.

Inspiration is very important, and so was finding a theme that could help develop the model. I got my initial inspiration from the LEGO Christmas houses and sea villages. I started by doing some sketching on paper, then created a mood board to determine the details and color schemes. Especially the use of the right colors was important in my design.

After submitting the model on LEGO Ideas, people commented and asked about the inside of the building. This was the moment where I decided I could really get creative designing something special for inside. It was a lot of fun. And it also got me thinking that the building could have a seasonal design with different faces for the winter and summer.

It turned out to be a fairly complicated model and it took some time to design the initial house and do the adjustments. It probably took me a couple of months to get it completely as I wanted it to be.

It only took six weeks for the model to reach the 10,000 votes on LEGO Ideas, which was very exciting. It was a lot of fun to read the comments and see that people were really interested in my model.

My tip for people who are considering uploading an idea is to just do it! Use your creativity and have fun. Even the simpler models get lots of votes. And you never know what might happen!

When you start out, the fun part is the idea that your model might be chosen to be developed as a LEGO set. But after submitting my model on the platform, the waiting, the comments from other LEGO Ideas community members and checking out how your model is doing are all very exciting. It all makes you want to check regularly on how things are going, but also to see what other cool designs are uploaded to the platform.

LEGO® DESIGNER

My task is to make sure that the model lives up to LEGO® quality. It can be quite challenging as I have to respect someone else's design, but at the same time alter it so it fits our guidelines. As a LEGO designer I have to be aware of the many rules and restrictions that a fan designer like Robert doesn't have to worry about. This could be small things like changing elements that are no longer available, or bigger stuff like changing measurements, building techniques or even whole sections of a build.

I tried to stay very true to the original design. That's what got 10,000 votes and is what the people want. I didn't want to change much of the original look and there was no reason to do so. As for the build though, probably not a single brick was left untouched.

It took quite a while to fine tune the measurements so that all the walls could be built with only 1x1, 1x2 and 1x4 bricks. This meant they could interlock and be covered with sand green tiles at the same time. Also the tiles simulating boards on the outside should ideally lock the bricks underneath. There are many ways to do this, but only one really works.

Even with all these structural changes, you would probably be hard pressed to find any major differences between the winning design and the actual product. It was therefore easy for me to discuss the necessary adjustments with Robert.

It was great to be able to bring back certain elements like the seagull, and use others like the lobster that were only previously available in other sets. We also have two new prints and a sticker sheet. I think we did a great job deciding what should be printed and what could be a sticker – and the model doesn't lose much of its appeal if the stickers aren't applied.

It was actually me who suggested the name "Anton's Bait Shop". He's my son and even though he's only seven months old right now, someday he'll be old enough to build the set and to understand the joke.

PARTI CONSTRUIRE!

Lorsque j'étais jeune, j'adorais jouer avec les briques LEGO®. Je me souviens que mon premier ensemble était le camion de pompiers 336. Après avoir eu mes deux fils, mon intérêt a été ravivé et on aimait construire ensemble des modèles LEGO. Surtout les ensembles de super héros, qui sont les préférés de mes fils. La pièce qui nous servait de débarras a été transformée en une pièce LEGO pour les garçons. N'en parlez pas à ma femme...

La pêche a toujours été une passion. De la pêche dans les Caraïbes, où j'ai vécu pendant un certain temps, à la pêche en Hollande. On peut donc dire que mon intérêt pour la pêche et mon travail de dessinateur en architecture ont été réunis dans ce modèle.

L'inspiration est très importante, tout comme la recherche d'un thème pour mettre au point le modèle. Je me suis tout d'abord inspiré des maisons de Noël et des villages au bord de la mer LEGO. J'ai commencé par faire quelques croquis sur papier et j'ai ensuite créé un tableau d'ambiance pour définir les détails et les palettes de couleurs. L'utilisation des bonnes couleurs a été particulièrement importante dans la conception de mon modèle.

Après que j'ai publié le modèle sur LEGO Ideas, les gens ont commenté et ont posé des questions sur l'intérieur du bâtiment. C'est à ce moment que je me suis dit que je pouvais vraiment faire preuve de créativité afin d'imaginer quelque chose de spécial pour l'intérieur. Je me suis vraiment amusé. Et j'ai également eu l'idée de donner au bâtiment un style saisonnier grâce à des côtés différents pour l'hiver et pour l'été.

Mon modèle est devenu assez complexe et j'ai pris un certain temps pour concevoir la maison de base et faire les ajustements. Cela m'a pris probablement quelques mois avant d'obtenir exactement ce que je voulais.

Six semaines ont suffi pour que mon modèle atteigne les 10 000 votes sur LEGO Ideas. C'était vraiment excitant. J'ai pris beaucoup de plaisir à lire les commentaires et à découvrir que les gens étaient vraiment intéressés par mon modèle.

Si j'avais un conseil à donner à ceux qui hésitent à publier une idée, ce serait de foncer ! Utilisez votre créativité et amusez-vous. Même les modèles les plus simples peuvent récolter beaucoup de votes. Et on ne sait jamais ce qui pourrait se passer !

Quand vous commencez, le moment amusant est de choisir l'idée qui pourrait permettre à votre modèle d'être sélectionné pour devenir un ensemble LEGO. Mais, après avoir publié mon modèle sur la plateforme, j'étais très enthousiasmé par l'attente, les commentaires des autres membres de la communauté LEGO Ideas et le suivi de l'évolution du modèle. Tout cela vous pousse à suivre régulièrement où en est votre création, mais aussi à découvrir les autres conceptions super cool qui sont publiées sur la plateforme.

LE DESIGNER LEGO®

Mon travail est de m'assurer que le modèle soit à la hauteur de la qualité LEGO®. Cela peut s'avérer délicat parce que je dois respecter la création de quelqu'un tout en la modifiant pour qu'elle corresponde à nos normes. En tant que designer LEGO, je dois prendre en considération de nombreuses règles et restrictions dont un fan designer comme Robert n'a pas à se préoccuper. Il pourrait s'agir de détails subtils comme le remplacement d'éléments qui ne sont plus disponibles ou de modifications plus importantes comme des mesures ou des techniques de construction différentes ou la création de sections entières d'une construction.

J'ai essayé de rester très fidèle à la conception d'origine. C'est ce qui a obtenu 10 000 votes et c'est aussi ce que veulent les gens. Je ne voulais pas beaucoup modifier l'apparence d'origine, et il n'y avait aucune raison de le faire. Toutefois, pour ce qui est de la construction, chacune des briques a été passée en revue.

Cela a pris un certain temps pour ajuster parfaitement les mesures de sorte que tous les murs puissent être construits seulement avec des briques 1x1, 1x2 et 1x4. Cela signifiait qu'ils pouvaient s'assembler et être recouverts de tuiles vert sable en même temps. En outre, il était préférable que les tuiles qui représentent les planches s'emboîtent dans les briques en dessous. Même s'il existe de nombreuses façons de le faire, une seule est vraiment efficace.

Malgré toutes ces modifications relatives à la structure, vous aurez probablement du mal à trouver des différences flagrantes entre le modèle gagnant et le produit fini. J'ai donc pu aisément discuter de ces ajustements nécessaires avec Robert.

C'était génial de pouvoir réintégrer certains éléments comme la mouette, et d'en utiliser d'autres comme le homard qui étaient uniquement disponibles dans d'anciens ensembles. Nous avons également deux nouveaux motifs imprimés et une feuille d'autocollants. Je pense que nous avons fait du bon travail en choisissant ce qu'il était préférable d'imprimer et les éléments qui pouvaient devenir des autocollants, sans pour autant que le modèle perde de son attrait si ceux-ci ne sont pas placés.

En réalité, c'est moi qui ai suggéré le nom « Anton's Bait Shop ». Anton est mon fils et même s'il n'a que sept mois aujourd'hui, il sera un jour assez grand pour construire l'ensemble et comprendre le clin d'œil.

¡ME FUI A CONSTRUIR!

Cuando era pequeño, me encantaba jugar con mis bricks LEGO®. Recuerdo que lo primero que construí fue el set Fire Truck (336). Cuando tuve a mis dos hijos, el interés se reavivó en mí y disfrutamos mucho construyendo modelos LEGO juntos. Los favoritos de mis hijos son los sets Super Heroes. La bodega que teníamos en casa se ha convertido en un cuarto específico para que los niños construyan con LEGO. No le pregunten a mi esposa...

Siempre he sido aficionado a la pesca. He pescado en el Caribe, donde viví durante un tiempo, y también en Holanda. Se podría decir que mi interés por la pesca y mi trabajo como dibujante arquitectónico van de la mano en este modelo.

La inspiración era muy importante, casi tanto como encontrar un tema que me ayudara a desarrollar el modelo. Al principio me inspiré en las construcciones navideñas y los pueblos de la costa que representan los sets LEGO. Comencé dibujando un borrador en papel y después creé un tablón para estudiar los detalles y colores. El uso de los colores correctos era particularmente importante para mi diseño.

Luego de enviar el modelo a LEGO Ideas, la gente empezó a comentar y preguntar sobre el interior del edificio. Fue entonces cuando pensé que podría diseñar algo realmente creativo y especial para el interior. Fue muy divertido. Además, eso me llevó a la idea de que el edificio tuviera un diseño estacional, con fachadas diferentes para el invierno y el verano.

Al final resultó ser bastante complicado: me tomó algo de tiempo diseñar la primera casa y llevar a cabo los ajustes necesarios. Es posible que pasaran un par de meses hasta que logré que todo estuviera como yo quería.

Sólo hicieron falta seis semanas para que el modelo recibiera los 10.000 votos en LEGO Ideas, lo cual me pareció increíble. Me divertí mucho leyendo los comentarios y descubriendo que la gente estaba realmente interesada en mi modelo.

Mi consejo para la gente que esté considerando enviar una idea es: ¡háganlo! Usen su creatividad y divíértanse. Incluso los modelos más sencillos reciben muchos votos. ¡Y nunca se sabe lo que puede suceder!

Lo más divertido al principio es pensar que tu modelo podría ser elegido para convertirse en un set LEGO. Sin embargo, luego de enviar mi modelo a la plataforma, la espera, recibir comentarios de otros miembros de la comunidad de LEGO Ideas y consultar qué tal estaba funcionando el modelo fueron experiencias muy emocionantes. Todo te invita a revisar con frecuencia cómo le está yendo a tu modelo, pero también a descubrir otros diseños asombrosos que se envían a la plataforma.

EL DISEÑADOR DE LEGO®

Mi tarea consistió en asegurarme de que el modelo estuviera a la altura de los estándares de calidad de LEGO®. A veces es complicado, porque tienes que respetar el diseño de otra persona y, al mismo tiempo, alterarlo para que se ajuste a nuestras directrices. Como diseñador de LEGO, tengo que tomar en cuenta muchas reglas y restricciones de las que un fan diseñador como Robert no tiene que preocuparse. Pueden ser cosas pequeñas, como cambiar los elementos que ya no están disponibles, u otras más grandes, como alterar las medidas, las técnicas de construcción o incluso partes enteras de un modelo.

En este caso, intenté ser lo más fiel posible al diseño original. Es lo que recibió 10.000 votos y lo que la gente quiere. No quería cambiar mucho del aspecto general y no había razón para hacerlo. En cuanto al modelo en sí, no obstante, es posible que no haya ni un solo brick que no haya recibido algún cambio.

Nos costó bastante ajustar las medidas para que todas las paredes se pudieran construir usando bricks 1x1, 1x2 y 1x4. Era la única manera en que podían embonarse entre sí y se pudieran cubrir con cubiertas verde arena. Además, lo ideal era que las cubiertas exteriores mantuviieran unidos los bricks que había debajo. Hay muchas formas de hacer esto, pero sólo una funciona realmente.




Incluso con todos estos cambios estructurales, todavía es difícil encontrar grandes diferencias entre el diseño ganador y el producto final. Fue fácil, por tanto, discutir los ajustes necesarios con Robert.


Fue fantástico recuperar ciertos elementos, como la gaviota, y usar otros, como la langosta, que antes sólo estaban disponibles en otros sets. También tenemos dos nuevas decoraciones impresas y una hoja de calcomanías. Creo que hicimos un gran trabajo al decidir lo que se tenía que imprimir y lo que podría estar en una calcomanía; y lo cierto es que el modelo no pierde mucho de su atractivo si no se le ponen las calcomanías.


