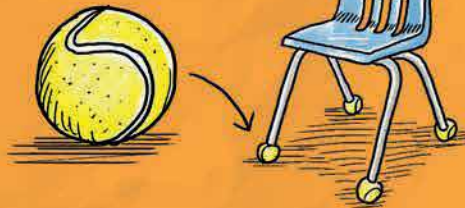

1 Donate old tennis balls to schools!

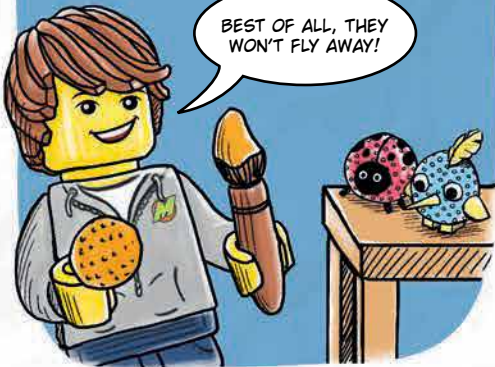


They will cut an "X" into them and put them on the feet of chair legs so that the chairs slide quietly.

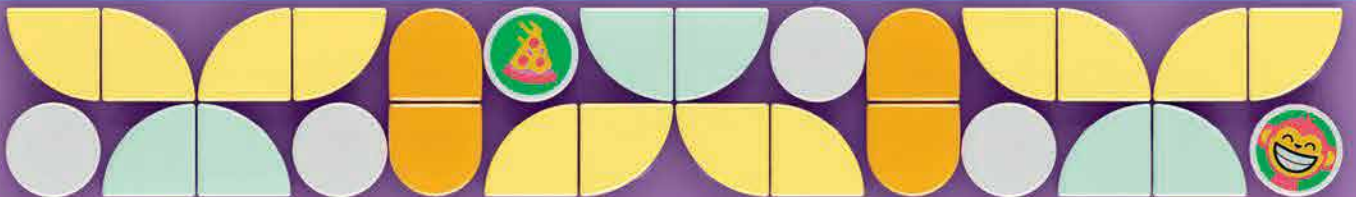
