



Red hibiscus flower (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*)





White petunia (*Petunia axillaris*)







Red garden geranium (*Pelargonium x hortorum*)
 The fragrant garden geranium serves both aesthetic and practical purposes in a serene garden. Its natural oils give off a scent that sends insects packing!


















Iberian waterfrog (*Pelophylax perezi*)



Spanish moon moth (*Graellsia isabellae*)
